Instructions and Requirements

Shoreline stabilization at Santeetlah Reservoir requires an Activity Permit from Brookfield Smoky Mountain Hydropower LLC.

To the extent that particular circumstances demonstrate the need for shoreline stabilization, vegetative plantings are preferred, followed by riprap and, in extreme circumstances (situations where a professional engineer indicates that site conditions prohibit the prior two options), retaining walls.

To be considered for an Activity Permit, the adjoining property owner must complete a two phase application process. The applicant must initiate the application process by completing and returning a Phase I Application. Please consult BSMH's Shoreline Management Plan (Appendix A-Shoreline Stewardship Policy) for detailed information regarding BSMH's procedures and requirements governing activities in the reservoirs, along the shoreline, or on Brookfield Smoky Mountain Hydropower LLC-owned lands.

Upon receipt of a completed Phase I Application, BSMH will contact the applicant to schedule an onsite shoreline stabilization evaluation (to be conducted by BSMH personnel). If shoreline stabilization measures are warranted, BSMH will provide the appropriate installation plan based on site conditions. During the onsite appointment BSMH will evaluate the vertical height of the eroded area, the reservoir exposure of the eroded area, fetch distance, any overland erosion, the proximity of structures to the eroded area, and the condition of vegetation adjacent to the eroded area.

During Phase II of the application process, applicants are required to get written approval of the proposed shoreline stabilization from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and the North Carolina Division of Water Quality (NCDWQ).
